# **World Snowman Day!**

Every January 18th is World Snowman Day! The number 18 was chosen to honor this winter symbol, as his shape resembles an eight, and the number one represents his stick. But where does this tradition of snowman comes from?

One of the earliest records of a snowman was from 7th-century northern China. It stated the followers of Buddha were given a blessing to build the man out of snow. Perhaps one of the most striking images of a snowman was created centuries later in the Netherlands.

Snowmen were a phenomenon in the Middle Ages, built with great skill and thought. At a time of limited means of expression, snow was like free art supplies dropped from the sky. It was a popular activity for couples to stroll through town to view the temporary works of chilly art. Some were created by famous artists, including a 19-year-old Michelangelo, who in 1494 was commissioned by the ruler of Florence, Italy, to sculpt a snowman in his mansion's courtyard.

It was a snowman who appeared on some of the first postcards, starred in some of the initial silent movies, and was the subject of a couple of the earliest photos, dating all the way back to the 1800s.

Making snow paint is a fun and easy DIY project you can do with your kids on a snowy day. Not only will you create beautiful and colorful artwork together, but you'll also have a great time exploring your creativity and imagination.




#### SUPPLIES NEEDED:
